

# Department of Energy - FIU Science & Technology Workforce Development Program

The DOE-FIU Science and Technology Workforce Development Program is an innovative program between the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Environmental Management (DOE-EM) and Florida International University's Applied Research Center designed to create a "pipeline" of minority scientists and engineers specifically trained and mentored to enter the Department of Energy workforce.



## The Program Includes:

- **HANDS ON** work with **mentors**
- **PAID SUMMER INTERNSHIPS** (10 weeks) at DOE Sites
- **PAID 20 HOURS** per week of research work at FIU's Applied Research Center
- **TUITION WAIVER** for Graduate students
- Professional **DEVELOPMENT** and **TRAINING**

## Program Requirements

- United States Citizen/Permanent Resident Alien (A minimum of 4 years of Permanent residency required)
- Undergraduate or Graduate FIU students
- Minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average

## Application Package must contain

- A completed application
- Two letters of recommendation from FIU faculty members
- Unofficial FIU transcripts
- Current resume
