Program Requirements:

- U.S. Citizen/Permanent Resident Alien (A minimum of 4 years of Permanent Residency)
- Undergrads (Sophomores/early Juniors and Seniors accepted to FIU graduate school)
- Masters/PhD students (first or second semester)
- Minimum 3.0 GPA

Program Components:

- Paid 20 hours/week hands on research during fall and spring
- Paid 10 week summer internships at DOE facilities
- Tuition waiver for graduate students
- Professional development and training

Application Package must contain:

- A completed application form
- Two letters of recommendation from FIU Faculty
- Unofficial FIU transcripts
- Current resume
